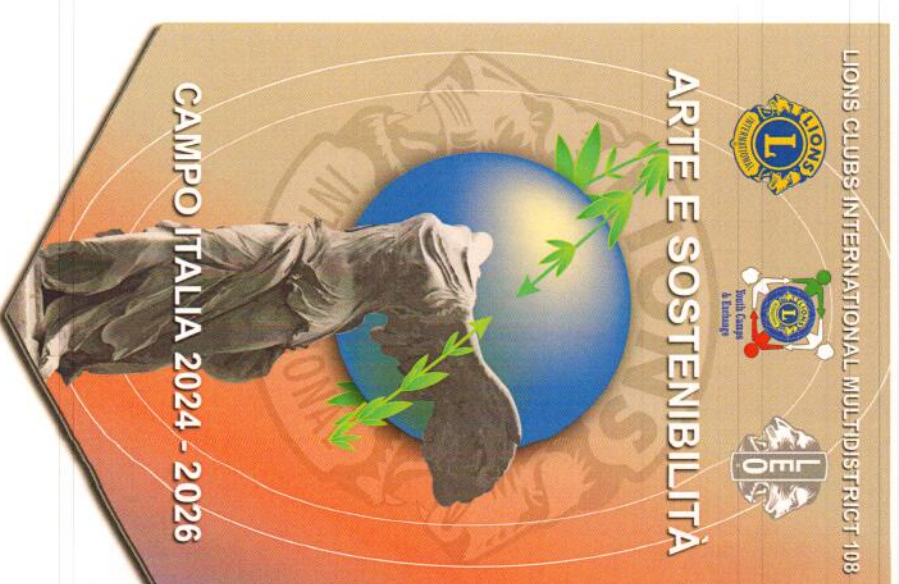
But it will also be an **INCLUSIVE** camp for blind children thanks above all to the contribution of the experience of Campo Emilia which will support us on this journey.
